At the 51<sup>st</sup> International Snowmobile Congress, David Low from Wayland, MI was named the ACSA Snowmobiler of the Year. Low has been active in organized snowmobiling for 44 years.



Low has been actively involved with the Wayland Snowmobile Club, the MSA Western Council of Snowmobile Club. He has also been very active with other snowmobile clubs, the Michigan Snowmobile Association and the American Council of Snowmobile Associations. Low has held several positions in the snowmobile clubs.
