❖ Obey the Rules and Laws of the State in Which You Are Riding

Stay on marked trails or roads and riding areas open to snowmobiling Check for any special laws, regulations or closures

***** Ride Responsibly

Respect the rights of property owners

Exhaust systems should not be modified in a way that increases sound levels Never ride alone

Let someone know your planned route, destination and when you will arrive Ride smart, be prepared and stay in control

Respect All Wildlife

Do not harass or harm wildlife or their surroundings

***** Respect Wilderness Closures

Respect those areas that are off-limits to motorized vehicles All users have a responsibility to care for and share the lands

Respect All User Groups

Be courteous to other people recreating Only pass when conditions are safe and never pass on blind corners Always stay to the right of the trail
