ACSA Future Leaders Program Selects Program Volunteer Coordinator and NGNR Ambassadors

The Future Leaders Program under the American Council of Snowmobile Ambassadors (ACSA) has selected a Volunteer Future Leaders Coordinator. Lori Clark will serve as the program coordinator. Lori is a part of the Oregon Sno-Blazers and the Mercer Area Snow Goers clubs within the Association of Wisconsin Snowmobile Clubs (AWSC) and lives in Oregon, WI. Lori has extensive experience working with youth and young adults in the snowmobile and agriculture communities. We look forward to having Lori help drive this program forward as we grow our next generation of leaders.

Additionally, the committee has selected two young adults to serve as the first ever, ACSA, Next Generation National Rider (NGNR) Ambassadors. These individuals will serve either the Mountain or Trails snowmobile regions.

Lynsey Burnzinski from Manitowish Waters, WI was selected to serve the Trails Region as the NGNR Ambassador. Lynsey is a part of the Mercer Area Sno-Goers and is a very active in AWSC and has been a Youth Snowmobile Rep for Rock County and is also a past AWSC Snowflake. At the club level she assists with fundraising, trail brushing, and learned to operate the groomer this year. Lynsey was an active member of the AWSC youth program, Kids and Adults on Sleds (KAOS). Presently, she is a council member of the Wisconsin Governor's Recreation Council as was recently appointed as chair to the tourism committee.

Korbyn Shaw, from Redmond, OR was selected to represent the Mountain Region as an NGNR Ambassador. Korbyn is a member of the Oregon State Snowmobile Association (OSSA) and belongs to three local clubs within OSSA. He will also be serving as the secretary for the Moon Country Snowbusters Club this coming season. Korbyn has 20 years of snowmobile riding

experience, along with experience in instructing skills clinics and snow bike riding. This past year he helped connect his snowmobile dealer and local avalanche center to partner in hosting a motorized specific "Know Before You Go" Avy awareness presentation at the start of the season.

Their term as NGNR Ambassadors will officially start on July 1st, 2025, and run through June 30th, 2026. The American Council of Snowmobile Associations is very excited to work with these young adults as they grow their snowmobile leadership experience and enhance the sport of snowmobiling.
